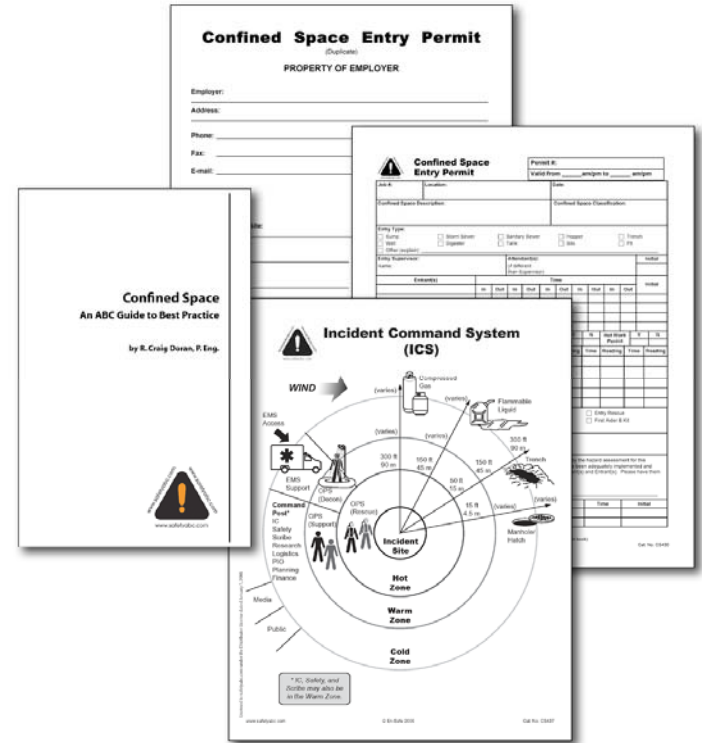

Confined Space Product Descriptions

CS 430 Confined Space Entry Permits

8 ½ by 11 or 8 ½ by 14 form to be used at the site level. Used to verify that adequate controls are in place based on a hazard assessment. The Entry Permit, in some circumstances, may be considered a hazard assessment.

CS 432 Confined Space Scribe Log

A document that can be used to supplement the Confined Space Entry Permit. Provides more detail of work being performed, listed in chronological order. It can be utilized for accountability of entrants and/or rescue workers. Speeds up assessment time during a rescue. The Attendant is responsible to keep current and accurate.

CS 433 Co-ordination Document

Utilized if more than one employer performs work in the same Confined Space or related work with respect to the same Confined Space. Communicates the responsibilities of the affected parties.

CS 441 Confined Space Inventory

What are the confined spaces your workers are exposed to? Utilized to clearly communicate to your workers what your organization considers confined spaces and their associated classifications.

438 Emergency Numbers

Quick reference providing a listing of emergency telephone numbers that can be updated at the site level.

CS 435 Confined Space Field Hazard Assessment and Entry Plan

Used to supplement the Confined Space Entry Permit (CS 430) detailing the associated hazards and the required controls including but not limited to emergency procedures. The format is constructed to mirror the sections of the Confined Space Entry Permit.

CS 434 Confined Space Entry Planning Meeting

Prior to work commencing in the Confined Space, this form can be utilized by the Entry Supervisor to document a meeting with all affected workers reviewing the scope of work and the required controls. All present for the meeting initial the form. Can be a substitute for a Co-ordination Document or be used as documentation for a restricted space.
